

## MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL

**BOYS:** Shirt – polo style (with collar) in maroon or white, long or short sleeve, finished bottom edge with hem, 2 or 3 buttons, may not be tight fitting, **collar must be worn in the down position.**

Pants – Tan khaki color (not green or olive green), length – below ankle, but not “dragging” on the ground.

Overalls – see pants. Belt – brown or black (MUST be worn if waistband is visible). **Style – Hemmed legs.**

**GIRLS:** Shirt – See High School Boys. Pants – See High School Boys. Overalls – See High School Boys.

Skirt – Tan Khaki color (not green or olive green). Length – no more than 2” above the knee **crease.**

Jumper – see skirt. Belt – see High School Boys.

## ELEMENTARY K-5

**BOYS:** See High School plus Shorts – Tan Khaki color (not green or olive green) Length – no more than 2” above the knee crease or 1” below the knee crease. Style – hemmed legs.

**GIRLS:** See High School plus Shorts – Tan Khaki color (not green or olive green) Length – no more than 2” above the knee crease or 1” below the knee crease. Style – hemmed legs. Skorts – see shorts. Jumper – See High School Girls. Overalls – See High School Girls.

## GENERAL NOTES:

- Shirts may be worn in or out. The length of the shirt must meet existing **JPPSS** dress code **found in Procedures and policy manual.** (i.e. cannot cover shorts if worn with shorts). The shirts/pants will NOT have any visible tags, logos, names, emblems or any kind printed, stenciled, or embroidered. This means even under the belt, if the tag can be seen, it has to come off. **Undergarments cannot be visible through the uniform.**
- Any shoes or socks may be worn as long as they meet the existing school dress code found in the **JPPSS Procedures and Policy manual.**
- Pants must fit, not oversized, NO wide legs and NO pockets, loops, slits, cuts, or holes on pant legs. NO Drawstrings, NO jogging styles. **Pants must be hemmed.**
- **Undershirts:** must be plain white, worn under uniform shirt (short sleeve undershirts may NOT stick out at uniform sleeves or bottom of uniform shirt), will NOT have collar, no writing, pictures/designs or embroidery, buttons, zippers, snaps. Winter undershirts: White turtlenecks may be worn as an undershirt only. NO OTHER COLORS.
- Winter wear: sweatshirts and/or sweaters may be worn if they are maroon or white. They must be plain (**without** any visible names, logos, pockets, zippers, buttons, **hoods**). The uniform shirt collar must be visible (i.e. worn outside the collar of the sweatshirt/sweater). Jackets must have sleeves, must zip, button, snap, Velcro, completely from top to bottom. NO PULLOVER JACKETS! No vests may be worn. Jackets must be open, **top to bottom**, once inside buildings. White turtlenecks may be worn as an undershirt only. No other colors.

The following consequences will be implemented as per policy:

1<sup>st</sup> offense: - Behavior report and parent contact

2<sup>nd</sup> offense: - **Referral and detention and parent contact**

3<sup>rd</sup> offense: - Referral and detention and parent contact

4<sup>th</sup> offense: - In School Suspension

5<sup>th</sup> and thereafter offense: - Out of school suspension
