(K-8th GRADE)

10 DAYS FOR THE YEAR

HIGH (9th-12th) -

For the Fall semester is 4.5 days and 5.5 in the Spring

semester. This is by each class. So if you are continually tardy for your 1st class you are not meeting attendance

requirements. Also, if you continually check out last class you are not meeting attendance requirements. The guidelines on days are getting stricter to stress the importance of your child being at school.
