NEW 2014-2015 ATTENDANCE POLICY , PLEASE READ!

These are the number of unexcused absences that will be allowed before a student is no longer eligible to pass a course or considered eligible for promotion as per the 2014-2015 Parish Policy Handbook: (K- 8th GRADE) 10 DAYS FOR THE YEAR HIGH (9th-12th) - For the Fall semester is 4.5 days and 5.5 in the Spring semester . This is by each class. So if you are continually tardy for your 1st class you are not meeting attendance requirements. Also, if you continually check out last class you are not meeting attendance requirements. The guidelines on days are getting stricter to stress the importance of your child being at school.

PLEASE NOTE

PARENT NOTES WHEN YOUR CHILD IS SICK, STAYS HOME, AND DOES NOT GO TO THE DOCTOR; ALLOWS THEM TO MAKE UP THE WORK THEY MISSED, BUT THE DAY IS COUNTED AS AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE AND IS MARKED AGAINST THE DAYS THEY CAN MISS AS STATED IN THE POLICY AND PROCEDURE BOOK.

REASONS FOR EXCUSED ABSENCES ARE ALSO FOUND IN THE POLICY BOOK.

WE ARE WORKING ON SETTING UP AN AUTOMATED VOICE MESSAGE SYSTEM THAT WILL CALL YOU WHEN YOUR CHILD IS NOT PRESENT AT SCHOOL . YOUR JOB IS TO CALL BACK THE SCHOOL AND LET US KNOW WHERE YOUR CHILD IS THAT DAY, HOME SICK, DR. APPT., DENTIST, ETC. OFFICE # 787-2577
